



At £18 billion, the Earl's Court scheme is the most valuable on-site urban redevelopment in the world outside of China. Now in our ninth year, the campaign by residents of the West Kensington & Gibbs Green estates has held back the demolition of decent homes and the displacement of a cohesive community in the face of planning permission and a land sale agreement.

Our vision is to transfer the 760 homes on our estates into community ownership: our Right to Transfer application awaits decision by the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government.

Our People's Plan for building new homes on the estates to meet local and wider need has overwhelming support from residents.

Our elected residents' Board steers the work and we have obtained funds sufficient to resource our project for the next three years.
